Who Should Attend? This session is designed for those who are looking for visual support strategies, including educators, SLPs, OTs, PTs, AT Specialists, Social Workers, assistants, administrators.

What Is It? This workshop will focus addressing the social skill development of needs of students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). While *Hidden Curriculum* that our schools have often frustrates learners with ASD, overall social skill development is critical to their learning, behavioral, and emotional development. Thus, this presentation will address ways technology-based solutions can enhance social skill development and build on communication and visual learning strategies already in place and used by both parents and educators. Participants will be engaged in a series of hands-on activities to teach them about best practices. They will also have access to a thorough wiki leaving them with resources for future use.
